



Haiti's Ministry of Health reports 142,870 have been hospitalized with cholera and 4,749 confirmed fatalities in Haiti as of 3/22/2011. The vast majority of patients are treated and released, as just 2,918 remained hospitalized.

The rate of death for patients with cholera has ranged from 1.5% to 4%. The current UN forecast the number of cholera cases in Haiti is 400,000 in the next 12 months. If the death rate remains constant at 1.5% to 4%, there may be 6,000 to 16,000 Haitians who die of cholera.

Unofficial estimates of the number of cases as well as the death rate are much higher.

13,129 babies and children under the age of 5 years have been hospitalized with cholera and 305 have died.
